TT Gigi is a half geometric, half grotesk, Sans Serif font family designed by Tankboys between 2014 and 2015. Gigi continues the research set-out by Aldo Novarese with his *Recta* (1958–1961).

TT Gigi is currently developed in 3 cuts:

Regular, Italic and Mono, with a large languages' coverage, more than 400 glyphs and several OpenType features. Further cuts are currently being developed.

TT Gigi is a custom typeface commissioned by a firm called Maikii.
